- Package Policy (General Liability, Property and Fire, etc) with Peerless Insurance Company at an annual premium of \$54,000, a decrease of \$385 from the current year.
- School Leaders Errors and Omissions Policy (Employer's Liability for Directors, Employees and Volunteers) with School Boards Insurance Co. of PA at an annual premium of \$22,939, a decrease of \$2,240 from the current year.
- *Umbrella Policy (Excessive Coverage above underlying policies)* with Old Republic Insurance Company at an annual premium of \$14,443, no change from the current year.

• Blanket Policy for PTA's, PTO's, Booster Clubs, etc. with Peerless Insurance Company at an annual premium of \$501, no change from the current year.

MOVED BY Rennie and **2**ND **BY** Stelts to renew the District's existing student accident and athletic insurance for 2007-2008 through Mid Penn Insurance Associates of Shamokin Dam, PA with ACE American Insurance Company providing the policies as summarized below and in the enclosure -

Interscholastic Sports, Intramurals, and Club Sports - \$6585.00 per year, paid by District (a premium reduction of 8.35%)

Voluntary Student Accident Coverage, School Time Only - \$30.00 per year Voluntary Student Accident Coverage, 24-Hour Coverage - \$116.00 per year

MOVED BY Schubert and **2**ND **BY** Stelts to adopt the enclosed resolution authorizing installment payments of real estate. Act 1 of Special Session 2005/2006 requires that each school district implement installment payments for real estate taxes. The law substantially dictates the provisions for the installments and further stipulates that each school district shall, prior to July 1, 2007, enact a resolution that establishes for the implementation of installment payments. Attorney Bartholomew has drafted a resolution that is modeled after the sample that was provided by PSBA.

MOVED BY Rennie and 2ND BY Schubert to approve participation in Trust, Trust Agreement, and Trustee for Lehigh Schools Consortium. The Lehigh Schools Consortium is composed of eight of the nine school districts in Lehigh County, Lehigh Career &Technical Institute, Lehigh Carbon Community College, and Carbon-Lehigh Intermediate Unit. The Consortium has elected to self-insure the dental benefits that are currently being provided to the employees of the member schools. As a result of this decision, the Board is being asked to take action as follows: "The Board of Directors of the Southern Lehigh School District approve participation in the Lehigh Schools Consortium Trust, approve the Trust Agreement (enclosed), and approve James J. Snell as the Trustee on behalf of the District." The trust agreement is modeled after a standard trust agreement provided by our benefits consultant, Elite Brokerage. It was modified and approved by the solicitor for CLIU, Atty. Michael Connelly, of Sweet, Stevens, Katz and Williams. The decision to self-insure our dental benefits is expected to generate annual savings for the District of approximately \$60/employee with dental coverage, or more than \$18,000 per year.
