Congratulations on the selection of Southern Lehigh Middle School as a host school for the 2012-2013 Teachers of Critical Languages Program (TCLP). TCLP, sponsored by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs (ECA) of the United States Department of State is designed to increase the study and acquisition of important world languages in U.S. schools. TCLP seeks to strengthen Mandarin Chinese and Arabic language instruction at U.S. schools, while also providing selected exchange teachers the opportunity to learn about U.S. teaching methodologies, culture, and society. This program is implemented by American Councils for International Education.

Selected U.S. primary and secondary schools will host a teacher from China or Egypt to teach Mandarin Chinese or Arabic, respectively, for one academic year. Awarded host school principals will attend the TCLP Spring Workshop on May 10-12, 2012 in Washington, DC, where they will be introduced to current exchange teachers and learn about program policies and opportunities. On July 23, the 2012-13 exchange teachers will arrive in Washington, DC, where they will have a two-week Orientation. On August 2-4, 2012, the mentor teacher from each host school will come to Washington, DC to meet the exchange teachers and participate in a Host School Orientation. American Councils staff will be in touch in the near future regarding travel arrangements for the mandatory Spring Workshop and Host School Orientation.

Included in this packet are important documents containing information pertinent to the TCLP program, including the **Terms and Conditions for Program Participation** and the **Mentor Teacher Finance Forms** (W-9 and direct deposit form) required for receiving honorarium. Your **Contact and Travel Forms** are available online, and do not need to be printed or emailed.

If you decide to accept your grant, please complete and sign all program forms listed in the following **Acceptance Package Checklist**. Please submit these forms **by April 11, 2012** to confirm your program acceptance.
