### Course Description:

Business Law is a half-year course designed to make students fully aware of their rights and responsibilities in contract law and to provide them with a basic working knowledge and understanding of the legal principles and the terminology that affect their lives as students, consumers, employees, and citizens.

### Course Requirements:

Each student is required to complete all projects, test and assignments. Each student must maintain a notebook with all class notes, worksheets, and handouts. Failure to do so will affect student's overall grade. Participation in class discussions and class work is part of grading.

### Grade Components/Assessments:

Grades will be based on the school grading system illustrated in the program of studies. Students are graded on weighted point system. The weighted point breakdown is as follows:

Assessments 40%, Classwork 25%, Projects 25%, and Classroom Citizenship 10%. Each marking period is worth 40% of a student's overall course grade. The final exam is worth 20% of a student's overall average: Quarter 1, 40%; Quarter 2, 40%; and Final, 20%.
