CREATING A NEW STUDYMATE ACTIVITY

Step 1: Make sure the *Edit Mode* is *ON* before you begin. The Edit Mode allows the instructor to edit content in his/her Blackboard course. This button is located in the upper right corner of the screen.

Step 2: Select the course content folder in which you want the StudyMate activity to be displayed.

Step 3: Click on the double-down arrows on the *Add Interactive Tool* button and select *StudyMate Class* from the menu.







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Step 4: Create a title for your activity and set the editing rights. If you will allow students to edit their own work, then select the bubble "*Only the original author can edit their items*". You can also check instructor items such as: *Once edited by the instructor, don't allow further editing (even by the original author)*. You can decide which items are important for your activity.
