What is StudyMate?

oStudyMate is a web-based tool that allows you to create interactive and engaging vocabulary activities and games using simple templates supplied by StudyMate.

oLog on to Blackboard

oYou can access it via SLSD web site by clicking on the Staff Center tab.

oLog on using your username and password

oUsername: sn99.peraltaj

oPassword: try your SLSD password

oClick on **Classes**

oSelect ***Southern Lehigh School District*** from the ***Class Catalog*** list.

oFind ***JoAnn Peralta's Workshop*** and click on the double-arrow drop down menu.

oSelect ***Enroll***.

oType in the password ***studymate***.

oThe enrollment process is complete.

Entering Terms/Definitions

- oStep 1: Click on *Workshop Assignments* to access the StudyMate activity.
- oStep 2: Click on *Select this item* to begin entering your vocabulary terms and definitions.
- oStep 3: Click on the **Edit** tab, this is where items can be entered through three templates: Fact, Term/Definition, and Multiple Choice templates.

Entering Terms/Definitions

- o For this workshop, choose the *Term/Definition* template and begin to enter the term and definition for the seven words that I have supplied for you.
- o After you have entered the term and definition, make sure to click on *Add to List*.

Playing and Viewing Your StudyMate Activity

- oStep 1: Once you have entered all of your words and definitions, click on the *View tab*.
- oChoose an activity.
- oBegin playing.

Creating a New Assignment in Your Course Content Folder

oIf you have a Blackboard course already setup, go ahead and access that course now and practice the steps with me.

oIf you do not have a Blackboard course already setup, no worries, just follow along with me.

Creating a New Assignment in Your Course Content Folder

- oStep 1: Make sure the *Edit Mode* is *ON* before you begin. The Edit Mode allows the instructor to edit content in his/her Blackboard course. This button is located in the upper right corner of the screen.
- oStep 2: Select the course content folder in which you want the StudyMate activity to be displayed.
- oStep 3: Click on the double-arrow drop down menu of the *Add Interactive Tool* button and select *StudyMate Class* from the menu.

Creating a New Assignment in Your Course Content Folder

- oStep 4: Create a title for your activity and set the editing rights. You can decide which items are important for your activity.
- oStep 5: Return to the course content folder and make sure that the StudyMate activity was successfully added to your course content.

Using the Grade Feature

- o The *Grade* tab, which is only available to instructors, lists each student in the course who has accessed the StudyMate Class activity.
- o Students who have not accessed StudyMate Class will not be listed in the Grade tab.

Using the Grade Feature

- When grading is enabled in the *settings tab*, a new column will be created in the native grade book and grades will be synchronized between the values entered on the *Grade tab* and the grade book.
- Once grading has been enabled and some grades have been saved this setting cannot be changed.
- Changes to the column should be made directly in the native grade book.

Where to Seek Help

- o Once you are logged on to Blackboard you will see the *blendedschools.net Resources* window.
- o Here is where you can access hundreds of tutorials on StudyMate and other Blackboard features.
- o Simply choose *BSN Knowledge Base Bb 9.1 Search* from the window and then search for StudyMate tutorials.
