OBJECTIVES

- To see the possibilities in how you may utilize StudyMate in your discipline
- To increase the student engagement level of your classes with interactive activities or games

INTRODUCTION

StudyMate is a tool that allows you to create ten interactive and engaging activities and games using three simple templates. The Flash activities can be used with any web server or published directly to Blackboard. StudyMate will import items from Microsoft Word files, Respondus, IMS QTI and other formats as well as publisher test banks.

StudyMate improves student knowledge of core concepts and terms through web-based learning activities. The activities such as flash cards and crosswords use glossary terms and facts entered by the students or instructor. Students then practice with the activities that appeal to them, and can even add new terms or sample questions that are also available to classmates. StudyMate integrates seamlessly with Blackboard courses for easy instructor facilitation and grading.

How will it enhance learning in my classroom?

ENROLLING IN BLACKBOARD

Follow these steps to enroll in JoAnn Peralta's Workshop:

- Step 1. Log on to Blackboard at http://blendedschools.blackboard.com/webapps/portal/frameset.jsp
- Step 2. Click on the Classes tab.
- Step 3. Select Southern Lehigh School District from the Class Catalog list.
- Step 4. Click on High School.
- Step 5. In the Search Catalog field, type the word peralta and then click Go.
- Step 6. Find JoAnn Peralta's Workshop and click on the double arrow drop down menu.
