- J. Thomas High School HVAC is down in 2 rooms, unless repaired there will be no air conditioning in those rooms. Facilities Director is working on HVAC issues.
- N. Castetter Reported nursing staff is limited, possible solution is to have more paraprofessional. At this time they will not be hiring any health paraprofessionals.
